

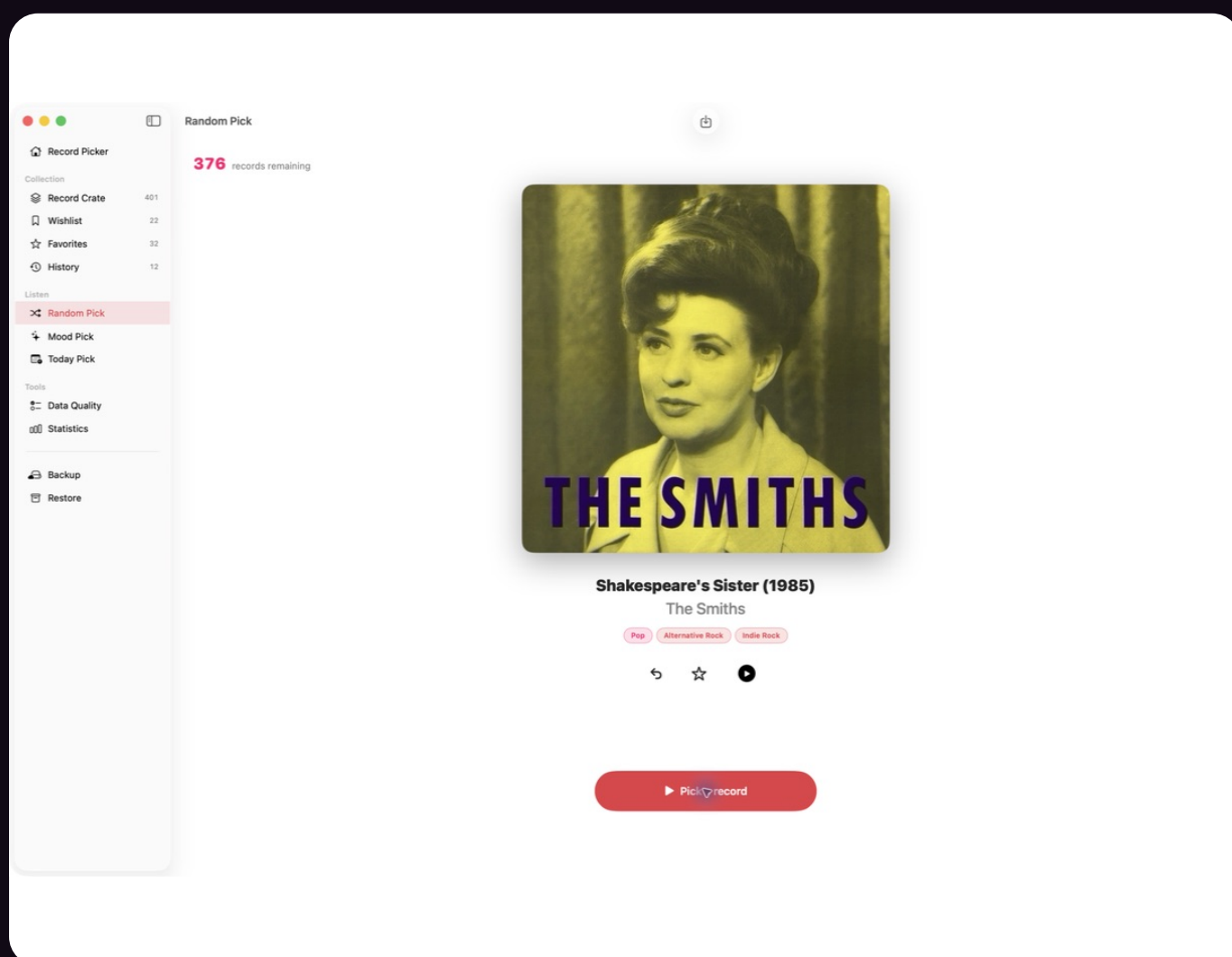

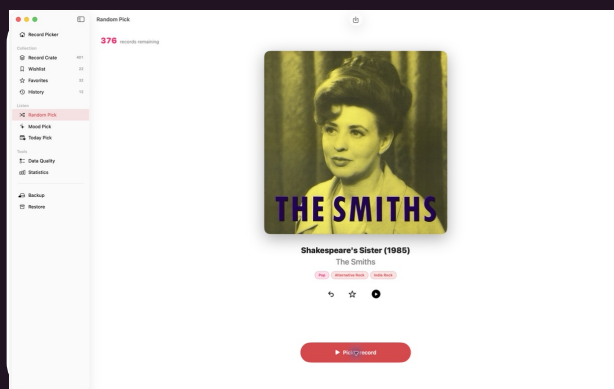
Three ways to choose

Random Pick

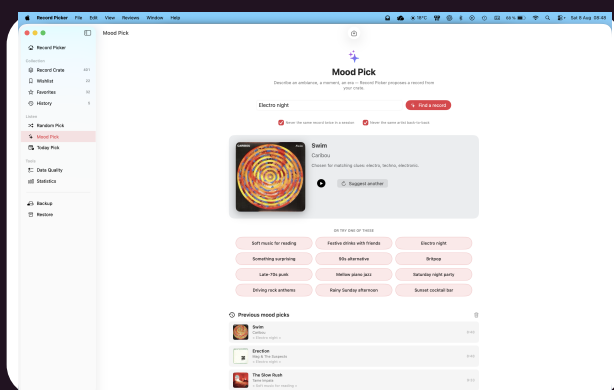
A standard or weighted draw that can favor less-played records, respect favorites, and prevent repetitions.

Mood Pick

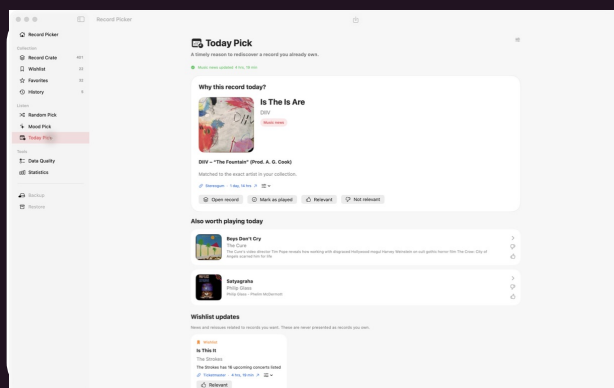
Describe a moment - quiet reading, an electronic evening, a rainy Sunday - and let Apple Intelligence select a suitable record locally.

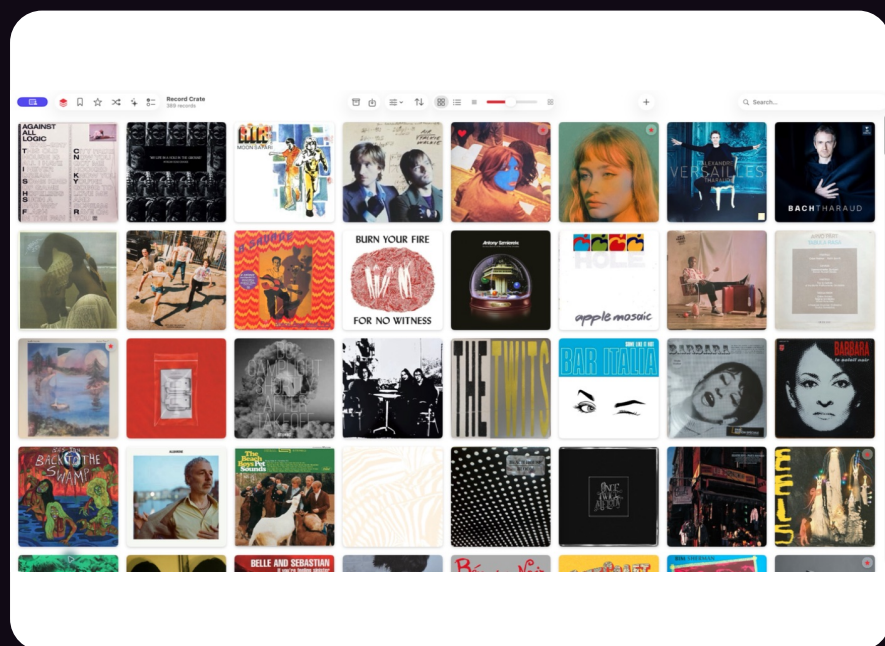
Today's Pick

Made for the Apple ecosystem

One collection, available in the right place: Mac for organizing, iPhone and iPad for choosing, and Apple Watch for one-tap control.

No account, advertising, or tracking. No third-party AI provider receives the collection.

Blurred cover artwork, thumb-friendly controls, and dedicated haptic feedback.

Classical collections cannot be reduced to artist and album. Record Picker includes dedicated fields for composers, works, catalog numbers, conductors, orchestras, soloists, and recording details.
